




Dear students,

NCHE approves Cavendish University Uganda to conduct Online Teaching and Learning

DID YOU KNOW?

The **National Council for Higher Education (NCHE)** approved Cavendish University Uganda (CUU) to conduct Online Teaching and Learning.

Cavendish University Uganda is one of the few universities in Uganda that did not completely shut down during the COVID-19 lockdown on account of its advanced learning management systems and remote working technology across a spectrum of functions. When the government announced the closure of all education institutions on March 20, 2020, the university complied fully and proceeded to facilitate most of its previous on-campus students to adapt to the new possibilities of online study. The Distance Learning office was enhanced and staff trained and equipped with the necessary tools and skills for remote working, teaching and learning. Remedial sessions were arranged for all students leveraging the already established advanced **Cavendish University Learning Platform (CU-LP)**. NCHE's **ODEL** assessment visit was consequently an opportunity for CUU to demonstrate its capabilities, leadership and systematic plans for digital education most of which the university had put in place well in advance to meet the evolving needs of today's lifestyles, only made more urgent by the COVID-19 environment.

The approval by the **NCHE** for **Cavendish University Uganda** to provide emergency **Open, Distance and E-Learning (ODEL)** per set guidelines will enable **Cavendish University** to fulfil its mission which is student-centred, at the same time, ensuring maximum safety against the spread of the novel Corona Virus that causes Covid-19. The approval is a milestone as the university positions itself to becoming a model university in Africa that delivers quality digital education that transforms students into responsible, educated, employable and entrepreneurial citizens.



In broad terms, lawyers apply their interpretation of the law (the codified rules of their society) to advise their employer or client on completing transactions in compliance with the law or resolving disputes based on current understanding of the law.

In more specific terms, lawyers can have a broad range of responsibilities depending on the specific area of law they practice. But if you think being a lawyer mainly involves making speeches and grilling witnesses in a courtroom, think again. Even trial lawyers—those who specialise in courtroom litigation—spend surprisingly little time before a judge or jury. For every hour in the courtroom, many more are spent doing research, conducting interviews, or writing documents in preparation for litigation. Many lawyers, in fact, never set foot in court. At its most basic level, a lawyer's role is that of an advocate and adviser. Attorneys use specialised knowledge to research and interpret the intent of the law and apply it to whatever circumstances their clients face. It's an imperfect practice, as interpretations of the law may vary significantly based on the circumstances of the situation.

The legal profession can be divided into two major categories: litigation and transactions. Litigation, which concerns both civil and criminal law, is the process of arguing a dispute between two parties. Transactions relate to business and personal matters that usually do not require courtroom argumentation. For example, a lawyer may counsel a client in the transactions of preparing a will, contract, or lease; to help secure venture capital for a new company; or to prepare a patent for a new technology. However, if the will is contested or if the venture capitalists sue the business owner for fraud, that would then require an attorney.

CUU offers Modern Distance Learning



About our distance learning programme

Cavendish University Uganda has developed two unique study modes. These are; technology-supported distance learning (DL) and the working adult (WA) programmes.

DL programmes are designed to deliver teaching and learning at a distance. In DL, students still have an opportunity to come to campus for a face-to-face engagement with their lecturers before sitting for their examinations.

While the WA programme involves both technology and a strong element of face-to-face classes. Throughout these forms of learning, the presence of the lecturer remains pronounced, but their role shifts more towards facilitation rather than leading the learning experience. Ultimately, the student takes the initiative to learn.

How unique is our DL programme and why offer it?

Using the latest learning technology which allows for study material to be sent at regular periods; as often as weekly, students can access work through multiple channels, including university-provided tablets, as well as on their laptops and desktops. The programme is flexible, accessible and cost-effective.

Our distance learning materials have been well developed by experts, primarily from leading higher educational institutions in Africa.

What are some of the benefits of this programme?

There is increased access to higher education, a personalised learning environment and support for offline and online learning through a university provided tablet (which is given out after students have paid a minimum of 50% of their first term tuition) with a strong battery life.

One can benefit from an adaptive learning management platform, submit quizzes or assignments, assess themselves and compare courses and collaboration with peers. There are chat rooms, system-driven alerts on grades, revisions and what to study. It allows students to learn at their pace.

DISTANCE LEARNING PLATFORM



Cavendish University's Distance Learning Platform provides a flexible, accessible and cost effective mode of learning as an alternative to the traditional classroom based programmes. 


He served as the Chancellor for six years out of the 12 years the University has been in existence, and he presided over 6,000 graduates representing 80% of the University's graduation since it started.

Registration and Entry for Ugandan Students

Requirements:

Direct entry

(a) At least five (5) passes at the Uganda Certificate of Education (UCE) obtained at the same sitting or its equivalent

(b) At least two (2) principal passes at the Uganda Advanced Certificate of Education (UACE) obtained at the same sitting or its equivalent.

Conditional admission will be verified after getting the Uganda National Examinations Board (UNEB) Results print - out.

Within the framework of the general direct entry requirements, there may be Special Faculty Requirements which a candidate must fulfil to gain admission to a programme in a specific Faculty.

Mature Age Entry

(a) A candidate must be at least 25 years of age

(b) The candidate must have passed Mature Age Entry Examinations with 50% mark or above

(c) The Mature Age Entry Examinations must have been taken at a centre approved by the NCHE

(d) No candidate who had previously attended a programme at Cavendish University Uganda shall be readmitted to the University under this scheme to a programme of study in which he/she failed to qualify during his/her previous attendance.

Registration and Entry for International Students

Requirements:


6.1 Must have a qualification that is recognised for University entry in his/her home country or country where he/she has studied. The applicant will be offered a provisional admission for one semester pending equating of his/her qualification.

The University may consider for admission to a degree programme a candidate who has successfully completed a 12 - year - system of education provided that such a candidate has been registered at another University, prior to applying to Cavendish University Uganda, for a degree programme and has successfully completed at least one year of university education. Such a candidate must, however, submit the University academic transcript from that other University.

6.2 A holder of a 12- year-system of education Certificate:

A holder of this Certificate such as the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education or the equivalent is required to successfully complete a Foundation Year before enrolling for the Bachelor's degree programme.





The coldest months of the year in Kampala on average are June and July, during which time the daily high temperature will generally reach the lower 80's.



TRANSPORTATION

There are three methods of public transportation: boda-boda, matatu and special hire taxis. The fastest method is the boda-boda; motorcycles that you see all over the city. You won't be in Kampala long before being propositioned by a Boda driver. If you're not interested, a simple "no" will get them to leave you alone. You can get almost anywhere on the back of one for between 1,000 and 2,000 UGX, but make sure you agree on the fare before the ride begins.



