



CALL FOR INTERNSHIP APPLICATIONS WITH EAGLE (ECO ACTIVISTS FOR GOVERNANCE AND LAW ENFORCEMENT)

As part of our commitment towards transforming and inspiring students to reach their full potential in employment, entrepreneurship and ethical leadership, Cavendish University Uganda (CUU) continues to partner with Industry as a way of building sustainable partnerships that will drive this objective.

CUU therefore invites applications from final year students in the disciplines of law, media studies and international relations to fill in 20 to 30 internship positions with (Eco Activists for Governance and Law Enforcement). EAGLE is a registered NGO network that works on wildlife law enforcement, and leading the fight against environmental degradation.

The internship is a learning opportunity aimed at attracting talented young men and women eco activists, who are strongly motivated to fight wildlife extinction, and protect the environment from degradation. It will provide an avenue for hands-on, practical learning in investigations, legal follow-ups, arrest operations, media exposure, deterrent, and mentorship with highly experienced professionals. By the end of the internship, the interns will gain valuable hands-on experience and exposure in the prosecution of significant wildlife traffickers, including the conviction and serving of deterring sentences, investigate and infiltrate criminal networks, identifying major wildlife traffickers and obtaining the required evidence against them, and create deterrent by raising public awareness of the increased enforcement of wildlife laws and the risks and penalties for wildlife criminals, and the related fields at the national and international arena.

A. Selection Requirements

- The applicant must be a student of Cavendish University Uganda, fully registered, and enrolled in an under-graduate or graduate degree Programme. The internship is also open to recent graduates of the University.
- Must be a final year student, or a student waiting for graduation.

- Innovative, has a clear sense of purpose and courage to pursue lasting and meaningful change
- Participation in Extra-curricular activities
- Good command of the written English, a quick thinker, problem solver
