Olympia is an exclusive invitational Debate Championship that brings together the annual best speakers in East Africa for a Round Robin Tournament with 5 rounds and the Grand Finale The debate attracted participants from Rwanda, Kenya, Uganda, Cameroon, and South Africa. The Chief Adjudicator for the Tournament was Mr. Fanele Mashwama (Harvard University, World Champion 2016 CA, WUDC 2019, SA) who was assisted by other independent adjudicators from South Africa and Cameroon.

The Guest of Honour at the Grand Finale was Rt Hon. Rebbeca Kadaga who was ably represented by the Hon. Richard Sebamala, the MP for Bukoto Central in Uganda's Parliament.

Universities that participated included; Cavendish University Uganda, Kyambogo University, Gulu University, Uganda Christian University, Mukono, Makerere University, Strathmore University, University of Nairobi, Nkumba University, African Leadership University, Royalty Pact Debating AAcademy, and the United States International University, Africa.
