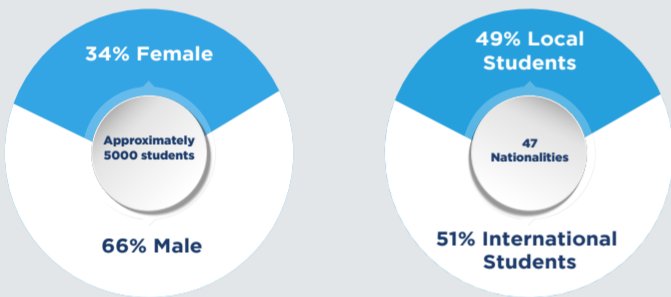

TUITION & FEES

Cavendish University Uganda's average tuition fees are structured as follows:

- **Undergraduate Programmes:** UGX 1,600,000 per semester (approximately USD 400).
- **Postgraduate Programmes:** UGX 2,300,000 per semester (approximately USD 580).
- **Annual Fees:** UGX 745,000 (approximately USD 190), payable once annually.
